* As you can see, there is no real consistency with regard to our student day (6 hours and 45 min. vs. 6 hours and 30 min. or other time schedules). We will need to work with the Transportation Department to determine the optimal amount of time needed between runs (Tiers) to truly establish start and dismissal times for each tier to adequately plan for all students' needs (including breakfast). We will also need to overlay the following:

- ✓ Non-Pubic School Runs
- ✓ BOCES / Alternative Ed. Program Runs
- ✓ Homeless Students Runs
- ✓ Number of Buses Needed for each Tier's Schools Selected
- ✓ Field Trips / Shuttles / After School Program Buses
- ✓ Away Athletic Contests

There will continue to be issues, impacts, obstacles and hurdles that will confront this option – as with any potential change to our current schedule. The key for me is to minimize the negative impacts while optimizing on any positive outcomes for **all** students.

Another factor to think about with regard to this "New" option is the expectation that all "Complex K-8 Schools" (Chestnut Hill Elem. & Chestnut Hill Middle; Liverpool Elem. & Liverpool Middle; and, Soule Road Elem. & Soule Road Middle) will ride into school together (AM) and ride home together (PM) . . . currently, LE & LM students ride <a href="https://home.ncm.nih.gov/home.n
